- A ballot vote will be taken, by the girls of the Assembly, to determine the choice of dress code as outlined below.

JEANS Only on certain occasions. SHORTS Shorts not above mid thigh. SHIRTS POLOS T-SHIRTS Shirts must contain <u>no</u> print that is offensive or controversial. Matching Assembly Polos or T-shirts are appropriate and suggested. 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GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Proper undergarments must always be worn and not be visible.
- Body piercing jewels should not be worn at Rainbow functions other than one pair of small stud earrings, worn in the earlobes.
- No visible tattoos.
- Clothes should be clean and neat in appearance.
- Always "DRESS FOR SUCCESS" keeping in mind that the attire should be AGE and EVENT appropriate.
- Be sure shirts are long enough that there are no bare midriffs when arms are raised.
